215 MARKET TOLL GRANTS

The following application for a Market Tolls Grant was considered: Fakenham Junior School Get Well Bell Appeal, to refurbish the school bell and its tower. Cllr Sandford-Cooke reported that the school had a revised quotation for the works of £27,000. This would be reduced by Contractors giving a 15% reduction taking the total to £23,000. £6,000 has been raised to date. The Chair of Governors for the school has written to County Councillor Tom Fitz-Patrick asking that the money set

aside for the demolition of the Bell Tower, if repairs were not funded, could be used towards repairs. The Chair of Governors has had no response. The school have put together a bid to the Heritage Lotter Fund. Pupils have ben fund raising e.g. packing bags at Tesco's. On the proposition of Cllr Vertigan, seconded by Cllr Acheson that £3000 is granted when they have secured the balance or a satisfactory funding bid. A counter proposal was made by Cllr R Smith, seconded by Cllr Sandford-Cook that £5000 is granted. A vote was taken on the second proposal of 3 votes for, 1 against and 4 abstentions. The second proposal was therefore carried as a promissory grant.
