Some concerns have been raised by local businesses regarding the parking of vehicles on the War Memorial side of the Market Place. The Clerk had spoken to the Market Trader's and asked that they park elsewhere which they did.

On the proposition of Cllr Acheson, seconded by Cllr Duffy that the Clerk and Cllr Crook purchase the banner at a cost of no more than £75. The Clerk will ask Highways if permanent signs can be added to the Town signs on the access roads to Fakenham.

61 REQUEST FROM WELLS TOWN COUNCIL REGARDING A PROPOSED ROUNDABOUT

Wells-Next-the-Sea Town Council have asked Fakenham Town Council to support them with a proposed roundabout at the junction of B1105 and A148. Councillors are happy to support Wells Town Council but would prefer the roundabout to be placed at the junction of Water Moor Lane. The old Norwich Road would then need to be upgraded. The exit from the Dry Road would then be 'stopped up'. This suggestion is in line with the road upgrade proposals for the northern development.

A request has been received to place a 'Geocache' box beneath the 'Jack Richards' seat. On the proposition of Cllr Acheson, seconded by Cllr Vertigan this is allowed. 5 votes for with 1 abstention.
