29	<p>COUNCIL'S ESTATE</p> <p>Trap Lane Pavilion – A tree is growing in the play area and needs removing. The Grounds staff will do this.</p> <p>Trap Lane Playing Field – A new surface is needed in front of the container. The Clerk will ask Carben for a quote.</p> <p>Whitelands- Grounds staff to cut back growth on footpath to Rudham Stile Lane. The Tesco 'Bags of Help' project raised £2000 towards new equipment for the play area. Laura Woods has also raised around £2000. On the proposition of Cllr Coates seconded by Cllr Holdom that this amount is matched by the Town Council to buy the piece of toddler equipment at a total project cost of £7796.00. All in favour.</p> <p>Railway Cutting – the path is overgrown and needs cutting back at least 1metre on both sides. Some of the trees need cutting back as well. Councillors would like to reinstate an access at the Holt Road end with possibly a zig-zag ramp. This will depend if there is still an opening near the Holt Road bridge. The Clerk will write to North Norfolk District Council (NNDC) regarding the planning permission and access on the section from Holt Road to Norwich Road.</p> <p>Millennium Park – The trees lining the centre path need the bottom branches and growth removing. The Grounds staff will do this. The skate Park area has had to be cleared of broken glass. The safety surface beneath the cantilever swing needs replacing. The Clerk will arrange.</p> <p>Queens Road Cemetery – Some of the graves are overgrown and need tidying, also the Yew trees need to have the ivy killed around the base. The Ground staff will do this.</p> <p>Quaker Cemetery – Some plant growth needs removing. The Ground staff will do this.</p> <p>Aldiss Park – Some damage has been done to the existing benches although they are still usable. The Clerk will investigate the cost of concrete benches. Councillors would like to make a wild flower area; The Clerk will contact Norfolk Wildlife Trust for advice.</p> <p>Goggs Mill Picnic Area– The fence has still not been repaired. The Clerk will look for another contractor. The bench is being painted this week.</p> <p>Hayes Lane – The trim trail has now been repaired. The grass around the play equipment needs cutting.</p> <p>Creake Road Cemetery – The Clerk has been waiting for a quote to repair the wall. She will try other builders. The gravel area around the tree near the extension is very worn.
