

19	<p>COUNCIL'S ESTATE</p> <p>Aldiss Park and Millenium Park – The Clerk reported that the litter on both of these areas is exceptionally high at the moment, The Groundsmen could litter pick every day. The Clerk suggested using 'cast iron' litter bins to try and reduce the amount litter on the ground. Two are needed; one near the skate park at Millenium Park and one near the picnic benches on Aldiss Park. The Clerk will write to other local councils including the District Council to ask what they use. Concrete bins were suggested and the Clerk will get some quotations. Email all Councillors with ideas and quotes. The Clerk will also get quotes of concrete benches.</p> <p>The play equipment and outdoor gym equipment can reopen of Saturday 4 July 2020. The Clerk will ensure that all barriers are removed by Friday 3rd July 2020. The new social distancing guidelines do allow for some distancing of 1 metre. Agreed to leave the 'A' boards used for the Market as they are. The District Council are also putting 2m markers on the pavements around the town.</p> <p>Decision Log - Roundabouts – this item will be discussed at the D & M meeting on 29 June 2020.</p> <p>Goggs Mill Road – The joint letter from Hempton Parish Council and Fakenham Town Council was sent to Norfolk County Council Highways on 16 March 2020. The response from the Highways Engineer is as follows: <i>I confirm receipt of your letter dated 16 March in respect of Goggs Mill Road. Unfortunately circumstances have taken over and for the next few weeks, possibly months, and it is likely that we will only be undertaking emergency type work or that work needed to prevent a danger arising.</i></p> <p>Millenium Park – the bent sections of fence around the Children's Play Area have been wired up in the interim. The Clerk has spoken to a local firm who will inspect and let the Council know the cost of repairs. The Clerk will chase.</p> <p>Railway Cutting – The worst of the litter is under the Holt Road Bridge. 20	<p>REVIEW OF CEMETERY FEES</p> <p>On the proposition of Cllr Hannon, seconded by Cllr Foortse with all in favour, that some of the fees are increased as follows:</p> <p>Part I – Interments, 1 (ii) The body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 18 years will increase from £160 to £175.</p> <p>Part II – Exclusive Rights of Burial in Earthen Graves 1 (i) For the exclusive right of burial for 50 years in a plot not exceeding 7 feet by 3 feet from £140 to £150.</p> <p>Part II – Exclusive Rights of Burial in Earthen Graves 1 (ii) For the exclusive right of burial for 50 years in a plot not in the Children's Section (up to 18 years of age) from £60 to £75.</p> <p>3 - Transfer fee for Exclusive Rights of Burial from £15 to £25.</p> <p>Part III – Monuments, Gravestones, Tablets and Monumental Inscriptions – a headstone not exceeding 4 feet in height from £135 to £140.</p> <p>The fees indicated for various heads of this Part include the first inscription.
